

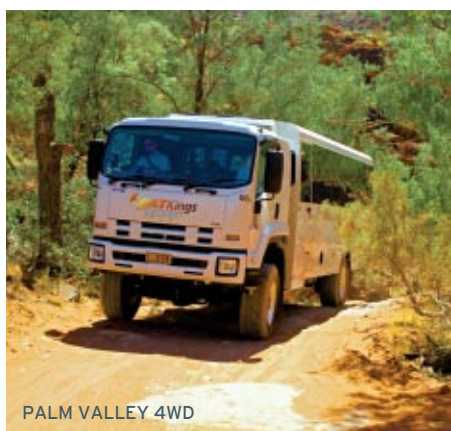
Alice Springs Sightseeing

National Park Entry Fee

You only have to pay the NP Entry Fee once when purchasing two or more Uluru & Kata Tjuta Sightseeing Tours as entry is valid for 3 days.

PALM VALLEY 4WD

½ Day Alice Springs to Ayers Rock Resort

Code: A6

Highlights: • Camel Farm
• Atila (Mt. Conner)

Travel south from Alice Springs through the West MacDonnell and James Ranges. Visit a camel farm where there is time to take a short optional camel ride (own expense) if you wish. Later stop at Mt. Ebenezer Roadhouse where there is the opportunity to purchase morning tea and locally made Aboriginal art (all at own expense). Pause to view majestic Atila (Mt. Conner), a significant sacred site, often mistaken for Uluru, before arriving at Ayers Rock Resort.

1 Day Uluru Adventure

Code: A2

Highlights: • Uluru (Ayers Rock)
• Kata Tjuta (the Olgas)

Travel from Alice Springs through the West MacDonnell Ranges. Stop at Jim's Place for breakfast (own expense) then later at Atila (Mt. Conner) lookout for morning tea. Travel on to Uluru - Kata Tjuta National Park. Join a base tour of Uluru and guided walk to Muġitjulu Waterhole where you can view Aboriginal rock paintings. Visit the Uluru - Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre and learn more about Tjukurpa (law) of the Anangu people. Visit Kata Tjuta, where you can take a walk between the massive domes at Walpa Gorge. Travel back to the Uluru sunset viewing area to witness the changing colours of Uluru while sipping complimentary wine or juice, followed by a picnic dinner. After dinner return to Alice Springs. **D**

1 Day West MacDonnell Ranges & Desert Park

Code: A7D

Highlights: • Simpsons Gap
• Standley Chasm • Desert Park

Travel west from Alice Springs following the spectacular West MacDonnell Ranges. Our first stop is at Simpsons Gap with its beautiful red gums. Continue to Angkerle (Standley Chasm). Walk along the stony watercourse lined with cycads, ghost gums, cypress pines and acacias. A light lunch will be provided before you depart for Alice Springs Desert Park. Explore the desert rivers, sand country and woodland habitats and discover many of the secrets of the Central Australian desert. Visit the Nocturnal House and witness free-flying birds of prey in the nature theatre at the Birds of Prey Presentation. Afterwards you will be transferred back to Alice Springs. **L**

1 Day Palm Valley Safari by 4 Wheel Drive

Highlights: • Cycad Gorge • Hermannsburg

This 4 Wheel Drive Safari travels through the West MacDonnell Ranges down the bed of the Finke River, one of the oldest watercourses in the world, into Palm Valley. Marvel at spectacular rock forms, white sands and an oasis of rock pools and palm trees. Visit the spectacular rock formation known as the Amphitheatre. Enjoy a picnic lunch within Finke Gorge National Park. We'll visit Hermannsburg*, an Aboriginal community and historic precinct which is renowned for its Aboriginal art collection and the works of Albert Namatjira. On the return journey to Alice Springs watch the changing colours of the West MacDonnell Ranges in the afternoon sunlight. (Morning or afternoon tea is included). **L**

Highlights: • Telegraph Station
• Alice Springs Reptile Centre

Tour the sights of 'The Alice' including the School of the Air which provides an educational service for children living in remote areas. Stop at the historic Telegraph Station and the Royal Flying Doctor Service. Learn how this marvellous facility operates to provide a 'mantle of safety' to the people of the outback. Visit the Alice Springs Reptile Centre where you will see unique Central Australian reptiles such as the Perentie lizard and Thorny Devil. Conclude with a panoramic view of Alice Springs and the surrounding ranges from the top of Anzac Hill.
